



***Acceptable Use Policy for Technology
Agreement***
For Grades K-2

St. Matthew School believes that all students should have access to technology when they act in a responsible, courteous, and ethical manner. Internet access and other online services offer an opportunity for students to access global resources and interact globally. Therefore, St. Matthew School provides the use of computer devices and Internet access for educational development of our students. In order for the students to use the computers and access the Internet, parents must give their permission.

Please review these guidelines with your child and indicate your permission for your child to use school computers and the Internet.

1. Use the computers, other electronic devices, and Internet only with your teacher's permission and for the purpose your teacher has requested.
2. Handle the computers and other electronic devices respectfully.
3. Your school computer files are not private and teachers may see them at any time.
4. Students will be disciplined according to the general disciplinary practices if they do not follow these guidelines or if they use the computers and / or Internet inappropriately. Consequences could be detention and / or loss of privileges.

All parents and students who attend St. Matthew School must sign and return this form. **Access to the Internet and computers (desktop or laptop) use will be allowed only when this form is signed and returned.**
